



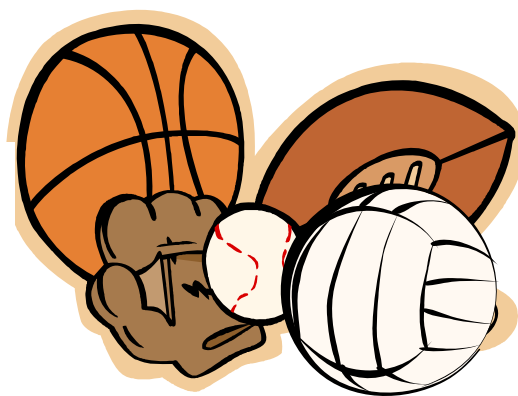

STANFORD TEN ACHIEVEMENT TEST 2009-2010 HIGHLIGHTS

Students in the Alabama Independent School Association displayed exceptional achievement on Stanford Achievement Test Spring 2010 test results. Test scores indicate that on an average, students in AISA schools score well above the national average in all required four grades (2, 4, 6, and 8) tested by AISA schools. AISA students scored: 21 points (71 percentile) above the national average in the 2nd grade, 22 points (72 percentile) above the national average in the 4th grade, 17 points (67 percentile) in the 6th grade, and 19 points (69 percentile) above the national average in the 8th grade.
