

**2019 - 2020 AISA All-State Academic Team
Nomination Form**
DUE IN THE AISA OFFICE NO LATER THAN March 26, 2020
(Duplicate this form if there is a second nominee from the school.)

1. Eligibility: Seniors at AISA Accredited schools.
2. Entries: Each school may nominate two seniors.
3. Criteria for Selection:
 - A. The student must have met requirements for the Alabama High School Diploma with Advanced Academic Endorsement or the AISA Advanced Honors Diploma.
 - B. The UNWEIGHTED numerical average (through 4 decimal points) of all semester grades earned for Grade 9 through the first semester of Grade 12 will be added to the highest Composite ACT or converted SAT score. (Note: The overall average cannot exceed 100.)
NOTE!! GPA'S NOT AVERAGED AS INSTRUCTED, WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED!!
 - C. The nominee must have earned all grades in traditional classes in the ninth through twelfth grades to be eligible for the All-State Academic Team.
4. Tie Breakers: The highest ACT or converted SAT score will be the determiner.
(Note: Unbroken ties will be placed on the team.)
5. Number of Team Members: The top 25 nominees will comprise the AISA All State Academic Team.

6. NOMINATION

- A. Nominee
- B. School
- C. Unweighted Numerical Average (through 4 decimal points) of all semester grades earned in grade 9 through the first semester of grade 12 (Note: Scores of more than 100 may not be used.)
- D. Highest composite ACT or converted SAT score

7. **Required Documentation** to be submitted with Nomination:

- A. Letter of Nomination from Headmaster
- B. Copies of the following:
 1. Transcript - grade 9 through 1st semester of senior year
 2. ACT or SAT label that reflects the composite score to be used
