CRITERIA FOR SGA LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

ONE SCHOLARSHIP PER CLASSIFICATION. (A, AA, AAA)

A SCHOOL MAY ONLY NOMINATE ONE CANDIDATE.

MUST BE A DUES PAYING SCHOOL TO NOMINATE A CANDIDATE.

SCHOLARSHIPS ARE FUNDED BY MONEY SECURED BY THE SGA.

THE CANDIDATE MUST MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. FROM A DUE PAYING SCHOOL.
- 2. A MEMBER OF HIS/HER SCHOOL'S SGA.
- **3.** A CANDIDATE FOR GRADUATION IN THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR.
- 4. A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF AT LEAST 3.0 ON A 4.0 SCALE IN A TRADITIONAL CURRICULUM.
- 5. AN ACT SCORE OF AT LEAST 23 OR SAT SCORE OF AT LEAST 1070.

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MUST BE IN THE AISA OFFICE BY MARCH 12, 2025.

- 1. À LIST OF THE CANDIDATE'S HONORS, EXTRACURRICULAR, LEADERSHIP, AND ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS.
- **2.** A SHORT ACADEMIC RECOMMENDATION BY A FACULTY MEMBER.
- **3.** A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FROM THE CANDIDATE'S HEADMASTER.
- 4. A COPY OF THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE ACT AND/OR SAT SCORES (LABELS ON TRANSCRIPT FILE).

THE JUDGING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE WEIGHTED IN THE FOLLOWING PRIORITY ORDER:

- 1. LEADERSHIP IN THE CANDIDATE'S SGA
- 2. OTHER LEADERSHIP ACTIVITIES
- 3. ACADEMIC RECORD AND ACT/SAT SCORES
- 4. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATIONS

NOTE: The scholarship will be awarded to the winner as soon as he/she provides documentation to the AISA that he/she has been accepted by a college or university. The AISA will mail a check to the recipient. The scholarship amount will be based on available funding.
