



OPEN POSITION: UPPER SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER & COACH

The physical education teacher must be able to communicate effectively through a relational approach, exhibit a passion for working with students, and uphold the highest standards of professional conduct. The physical education teacher is a part of the upper school faculty and reports to the upper school principal. All members of the faculty are expected to contribute to chapel and other spiritual development activities and other duties as assigned.

Major responsibilities:

- Prepare appropriate weekly lesson plans including instructional objectives, learning activities and assessments integrated with Biblical foundations
- Appropriately map physical education curriculum and maintain appropriate pacing
- Be alert to the social and emotional needs of students
- Demonstrate the maturity to inspire student learning and understanding of the age group
- Effectively communicate and partner with parents in the educational and spiritual development of students
- Support school initiatives and show support for student interests outside of the school day
- Coach or assist with athletics two out of three seasons

Possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in physical education, health, or a related content area

Exhibit a strong faith and exemplary lifestyle.

Have experience using classroom technology, electronic resources, programs, and platforms
