

AISA ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION PERMIT

(Revised 2026)

We, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree to the following:

I. Participation and School Responsibilities

The member school agrees to provide:

- Appropriate supervision of all athletic activities
- Qualified instruction and coaching
- Proper and safe equipment, including equipment provided by the participant
- A safety orientation program for all participants
- Instruction regarding:
 - Rules of the sport
 - Expectations for behavior, dress, and conduct
 - Safety procedures and injury prevention
 - Procedures to follow in the event of an injury

II. Acknowledgment of Risk

We understand that participation in interscholastic athletics involves inherent risks, including but not limited to:

- Mental distress
- Serious injury, death, or permanent disability
- Other risks associated with athletic competition and training

We acknowledge that these risks exist even when reasonable precautions are taken.

III. Participant and Parent Responsibilities

The student-athlete and parent/guardian agree that:

- The student will abide by all team, school, and AISA rules, policies and procedures
- The student will demonstrate appropriate sportsmanship and conduct
- The student will use equipment properly and report unsafe conditions
- The student will immediately report any injury or health concern

IV. AISA Handbook Acknowledgment

We acknowledge that:

- We have received or have access to the AISA Athletic Handbook
- We understand that participation is a privilege, not a right
- We agree to abide by all AISA rules, policies, eligibility requirements, and decisions

We understand that:

- Eligibility is managed by the AISA adopted policies and procedures
- If eligibility is in question, the student-athlete is considered ineligible until verified

V. Eligibility and Participation Agreement

We understand that:

- The school is responsible for determining eligibility at the local level
- AISA has final authority on eligibility matters
- Questions regarding eligibility should be directed to the school and not the AISA office

If a student-athlete participates while ineligible:

- Contests may be forfeited
- The school may be subject to penalties

We acknowledge that:

- Participation in AISA athletics is voluntary
- The school retains control over participation decisions
- AISA rulings remain in effect unless changed through proper procedures

VII. Medical and Safety Acknowledgment

We certify that:

- The student-athlete is physically able to participate
- All required medical forms have been completed and submitted
